FOLLOW ME

WEEK 4-THE TEMPTATION OF JESUS

OVERVIEW

In this message we will walk with Jesus through his moments of testing in the wilderness. We will see not only that he remains true to the heart of God and resists the temptations of the Evil One, but also that his means of *doing* this is through deep internalization and meditation on Scripture. Unlike the ancient Israelites who *failed* their tests in the wilderness, our rabbi here demonstrates that the way to endure trials is not through willpower alone, but through dependence on and trust in the Word of God.

"Get out of here, Satan," Jesus told him. "For the Scriptures say, 'You must worship the LORD your God and serve only him.'"

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What does trusting God look like?
- 2. What is the significance of following God's heart rather than following your gut?
- 3. Read Job 11:13-19 and Proverbs 3:5-6.
 - a. Discuss the importance of having a heart fully surrendered to God.
- **4.** Barry asked the question, "Who do you worship?" Read <u>Matthew 4:10</u>, <u>Matthew 6:21</u>, <u>Exodus 20:3-10</u>, and <u>Isaiah 45:5-6</u>. Why does this matter?
- 5. How well do you know the Word of God?
 - a. Why is this important as a Disciple of Jesus? Read John 8:31-32 and Hebrews 4:12.
- 6. How confident and content are you in your relationship with the Lord?
 - a. Do you trust Him when life presents problems?
 - b. If not, what are some steps you could take to change this?
